In one of WYSA's first games of the week for the 2006-2007 Indoor season, the U-14 female teams from Lord Roberts and Oakbank went head-to-head in a matchup that was hard fought until the end.

Before the game we had a chance to speak with Lord Roberts veteran coach Charlie Ironside, who thought his girls might be in for a long night against a very strong and balanced Oakbank side.

The Lord Roberts girls were quick off the opening whistle as Rebecca Acosta got off a good strike in the first minute, but Oakbank forward Ashley Rush made good on her first shot beating the Lord Roberts keeper,

Chelsea Saunders, high to the far post.

Right from the kick off Oakbank went on the attack again as Rush picked up a rebound off the back wall but Chelsea Saunders was able to block the hard drive. Lord Roberts countered off the goal kick which resulted in Acosta's first of three goals on the night. At 4:30 p.m. Oakbank went ahead on a lovely goal by Stepheny Vicente. A minute later Alyssa Henchert beat Chelsea Saunders on a breakaway giving Oakbank a 3-1 lead that they took to the half.

It looked like Oakbank might run away and hide when Rachael Valente scored five minutes into the second half to go up 4-1. Ashley Rush had several more chances including one that almost slipped through the Lord Roberts goalkeeper's legs.

Lord Roberts midfielder Connie McMahon-Wiebe showed some real finesse

bringing the ball out of her end and setting up Jessica Schorn to pull them to within two, but Stepheny Vicente replied soon after on a breakaway set up by her goalkeeper's long punt. Vicente scored her third goal of the night soon after to put Oakbank up 6-2.

It seemed like Lord Roberts was out of the match when Acosta struck again with two quick goals on one shift with less than five minutes to go in the game. With two minutes left on the clock Sara Janowski drove a direct free kick from outside the box straight into the net to bring Lord Roberts to within one goal. With Lord Roberts pushing to equalize, Oakbank took its fifth foul of the half to give Lord Roberts a power play in the final minute. Jankowski had a strong last minute shot but the Oakbank keeper made the save to preserve the 6-5 victory for her squad.
