Pipedream becomes reality

The idea for an Osborne Village Neighbourhood Plan has been in the cards since the 1970s but it finally hit the council floor at the City Centre Community Committee on Nov. 14.

As a project she has been pushing for throughout her tenure on council, Coun. Jenny Gerbasi (Fort Rouge-East Fort Garry) almost drooled when the last item on the agenda came up.

David Marsh from the City's planning and property department made the application and explained the document would act as a secondary plan that aims to provide a middle layer between Winnipeg's two main development codes: Plan Winnipeg and Bylaw 6400.

Marsh went on to explain the area has been broken up into three separate density levels, high, medium and low.
